❖ **Save the date** – On June 6 at 6:00 p.m. our church pastors will be hosting a Volunteer Dinner for all church volunteers and their families.

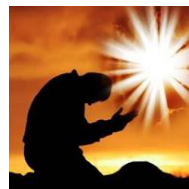
❖ **Female college student** is looking for a room to rent while studying dental hygiene at Clark College. Please contact the church office for more information if you have space to rent.
