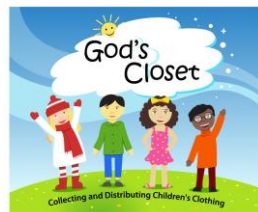
Welcome to the Adventist Community Church of Vancouver
