❖ **Friend and former member** Pearl McKinstry passed away last week. A memorial service will be held in Vancouver at a later date.

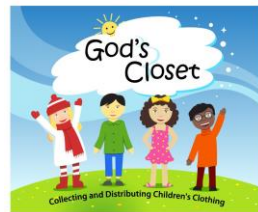

❖ **Prayer Meeting** will not be held during the America in Bible Prophecy Meetings. Look for it to continue in late May.

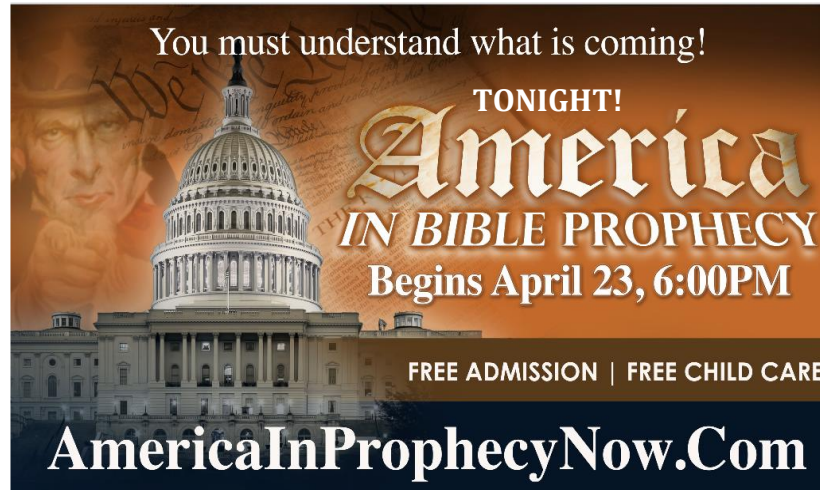
