❖ **CCACS Need for the month of October:** peanut butter. If you are able, buy a few jars, or more, and place them in the basket in the lobby.

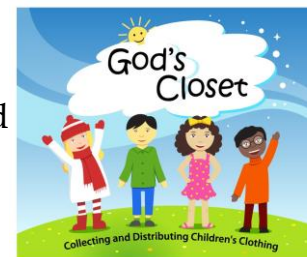
