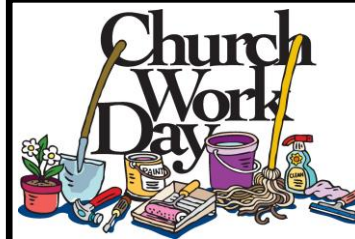
We Want You!!

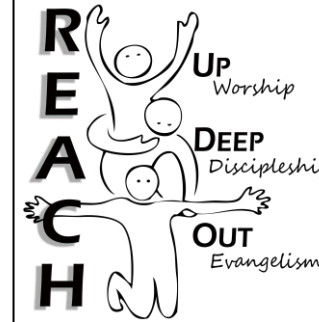
