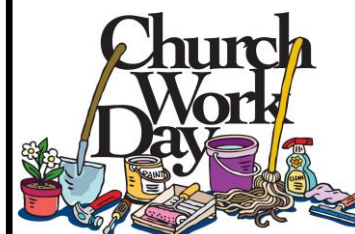
We Want You!!
